Use varying setts, 20 for the 8/2 stripes, thread 2221,2221, 17 for the 8/2 - boucle sections, thread 221,221, 15 for the all boucle sections, thread 212121

10-dent reed

Using JST Brassard boucle cotton with the 8/2 to soften it.

Pinks and oranges towels for guild challenge came out well.

Plain weave seems to work best for this combination of warps.

Can also do basketweave if it's not too close together.

Got 7 towels plus a end of warp piece out of this. Plain weave is best. Came out nice.
